4. SPC recommended to support the project and to offer an amount of **Rs. 2,00,000/-** under the following budget heads.



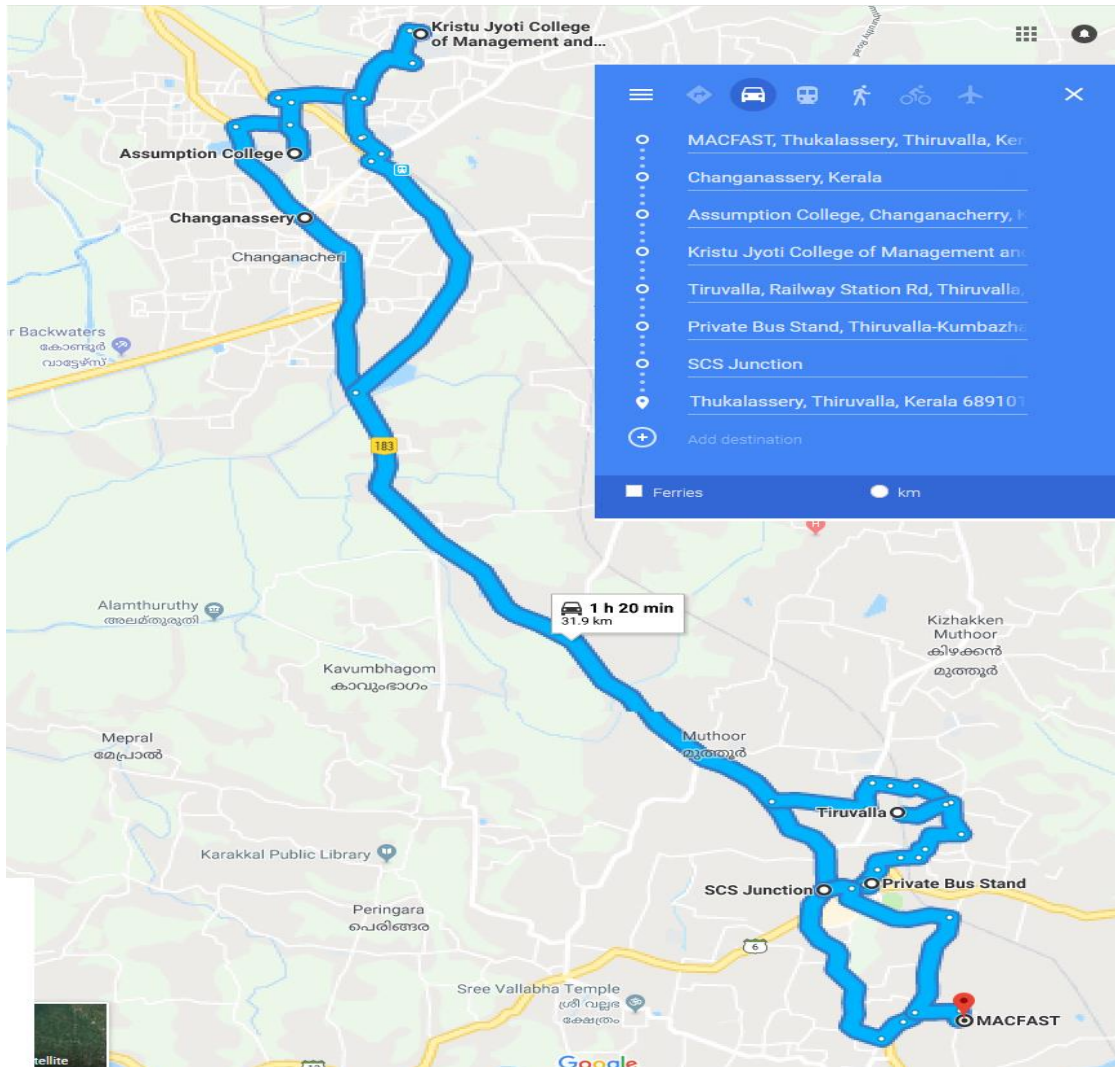
