
Report on mega job fair DISHA


Cultural Night

- Flood Relief Fund Collection MBA students of MACFAST have participated in the 'Flood Relief Fund Collection', a programme of Govt. of Kerala under the


- direction of the District Collector Pathanamthitta in association with the Municipality of Thiruvalla on 18th September 2018.
