




## Report of activities related to clean and green campus and celebrating environment day




# Report and list of student representatives for the conduct of paper presentation panels and other activities of international conference 2019






#### **Report of Onam celebrations 2019**








### Report of Christmas celebrations





#### **MINI MARATHON 2019**
