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AWARENESS ON CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

At the commencement of every programme, a two to five-days orientation cum induction programme followed by a two to three-week bridge course is offered to the newly admitted students every year. The goal of the orientation programme is to create student's familiarity with the institution's regulations and academic standards, acquaint the students with their classmates, to learn about the other institutional members and to give preliminary insight on the course being offered.

During this programme students will be thoroughly briefed about the rules and regulations of the college, structure of their courses, University regulations regarding the courses, importance and scope of their programme, etc. This programme will be conducted by the Principal, Head of the Departments, faculty members and experts from academics and industries.

Apart from Orientation Programmes, Bridge Courses also will be conducted by the concerned departments. This is a hand-holding phase for the newly inducted students. This course gives a superior progress stage to set themselves up before the beginning obviously for the primary semester. To overcome any barrier between subjects learned at the UG level and subjects they would concentrate on PG Programme. These courses also help to bring back the slow learners to the mainstream classes to the best of their potential. The content is so built up, that the self-confidence of the students enhances to face questions/exams and create awareness about incremental learning. it is intended to facilitate the bridging of the gap between the UG level and professional education.


