#### INTRODUCTION

The MACFAST Knowledge Scheme (MAKS) is an endeavour of MACFAST to bigger knowledge revolution by identifying, training, and developing talented school students providing an opportunity for social change and personal growth. The program aims at students studying in the seventh grade leading to a continuous association till the tenth grade during which several sessions would be given to help them develop their skills and qualities. MACFAST promotes institution-neighbourhood-community network and student engagement, contributing to good citizenship, service orientation and holistic development of students through this unique programme MACFAST Knowledge Scheme (MAKS) initiated by the college in 2011 with a view to disseminate knowledge to the neighbourhood schools. Selected meritorious high school students of Pathanamthitta, Idukki, Kottayam and Alappuzha districts are given continuous training programmes for four years during the Onam, Christmas and Annual vacation as residential coaching. The aim is to instil the students self-confidence and the capability to attend any type of competitive examinations starting with PSC/UPSC exams to Civil Service exams like IAS, IPS and IFS. #### Conclusion




