College Profile

MACFAST is a Post Graduate institution started in 2001, with the objective of offering specially designed courses in Biosciences such as Bioinformatics, Biochemistry, Plant Biotechnology, Biotechnology, Food Science and Technology and Phytomedical Science and Technology in addition to MBA and MCA. MACFAST is owned and managed by Corporate Educational Agency of the Catholic Archdiocese of Thiruvalla. The college is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam and located in the commercially active town of Thiruvalla. MACFAST owns an on campus Community Radio Station. Radio MACFAST 90.4 is the first on campus Community radio in the State and 46th in the Country. MACFAST College has reached yet another acme by decorating a position of First solar campus in India. It envisages to utilizing alternate sources of energy for a sustainable future. This solar project has a capacity of 30KW and 30-40% of the total energy requirement of the campus

N.S.S Unit MACFAST

MACFAST N.S.S Unit commences it activity in the year 2012. Since its inception it has done various social activities in around Thiruvalla, which include Clean & Green Campign, War against Drug, Blood Donation Campaign, Plastics Awareness Campign, and Various cleaning activities in Temples & Nearby places in Thiruvalla. N.S.S Unit of MACFAST has participated in Puniyam Poonkavanam Cleaning project at Sabarimala, during the Mandala Kalam in December 2017. Presently it has a sanctioned strength of one unit.

Background

As part of N.S.S Activities under the direction of N.S.S Coordinator, Mahatma Gandhi University Kottayam, N.S.S of MACFAST has participated Jaivam Literacy campaign in Payipad Punchayat during the September 2017 during Onam Holidays. During the process 50 N.S.S volunteers had visited more than 2000 houses in Payipad Punchayat and conducted the Jaivam Literacy survey. Most of the Ward members & Asha workers of the ward had helped the students and accompanied them during their visit in the houses of the Payipad Punchayat. The program was a great success with completing the survey in time bound manner. Payipad Punchayat had issued a completion certificate as well for the same.

Vidyarthi Jaiva Karshaka Samithi (VJKS) Institutional Farming

As a continuation of the Jaivam Campaign activates and as per the direction of Jaivam Organizing committee, we have decided to have a Vidyarthi Jaiva Karshaka Samithi(VJKS), to introduce and encourage Jaivam farming among the students. The main focus will be the institutional farming to cultivate an Organic Farm in the MACFAST campus using Jaivam cultivation methods. The main aim of the program is to make involvement for the students in organic farming practices. MACFAST will provide a space for the students of about 12 cents in its campus for the students for the VJKS activities.

- 2. Sowing/ planting seeds & seedlings of selected vegetables & fruits
- 3. Construction of an aquaponics tank
- 4. Usage of Solar Energy in the farming




HERBAL GARDEN

The Herbal Garden maintained by the college serves the purpose of education, research and conservation of germplasm of medicinal and aromatic plants, wide varieties of endangered species, dye-bearing plants and other species of ecological or economic interests. By maintaining the Herbal Garden, the College help young generation to learn the fascinating world of herbal plants. At present more than 500 indigenous medicinal plants, including rare and endangered species are maintained in the garden. The herbal garden of the college is funded by National Medicinal Plant Board. The garden is now maintained by the institute with sustainable garden management. Student interns help in the maintenance of herbal garden and that creates an opportunity for experimental learning on weeding, planting, supplying nutrition, creating garden beds and maintaining plants. Weekly allocation of green hour in the curriculum also helps the students to enhance the activities related to herbal garden.
