
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE




1.Installation of Biometric Gate Attendance System

MLIC has installed Biometric Gate Attendance System on 14/03/2022.


2. Digital Library and Internet Browsing Centre

Assistant Professor, Dept. of Management Studies has been appointed as the Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell.




NAAC 2nd Cycle of Accreditation







WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION 2022

4. INTERNATIONAL DAY OF FORESTS CELEBRATIONS - PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION


