

Decisions

- It was decided to promote student participation in NPTEL courses to enhance their learning opportunities. Dr. Jeny was entrusted with coordinating this initiative, including publicizing the courses as they are announced. HODs will monitor student enrolments to ensure active participation.
 - The IQAC will coordinate the activities required for the institution's participation in the NIRF 2024 rankings. This includes gathering and organizing the necessary data and ensuring timely submission to strengthen the institution's ranking.
- Dr. Smitha Vijayan will oversee the coordination of activities related to the green audit. This initiative aims to promote sustainable practices within the campus, focusing on energy conservation, waste management, and environmental responsibility.
- The Heads of Departments (HODs) were tasked with planning and organizing international conferences within their respective domains. They can also collaborate to conduct multidisciplinary conferences, which would broaden the scope and impact of these academic gatherings.
- To bridge the gap between industry and academia, it was recommended to conduct expert talks on emerging areas. HODs will coordinate these sessions, ensuring that students benefit from insights into the latest industry trends and technological advancements.
- The Computer Applications Department was entrusted with organizing a technical skill enhancement program for non-teaching staff. This training will focus on improving their technical competencies, thereby increasing their efficiency in administrative functions.

 It was recommended that industrial visits be organized for students across all departments. These visits aim to provide practical exposure and insight into industry operations, enhancing students' understanding of their respective fields.

 and agreed on its submission to the NAAC portal. The responsibility for this task was
 entrusted to the IQAC, ensuring all necessary documentation is accurately completed
 and submitted on time.
- To prepare students for UGC-CSIR competitive exams, a training program was proposed. Dr. Jeny was entrusted with coordinating this initiative, aimed at raising awareness and helping students successfully clear these exams.
- To enhance academic writing skills among researchers and students, it was decided to organize a workshop focused on this area. The Biosciences Department was entrusted with the responsibility of planning and conducting this workshop.
- Recognizing the importance of intellectual property rights in research, a workshop on IPR will be conducted. The Biosciences Department was again assigned this task, with a focus on educating participants about patent laws, copyrights, and other relevant topics.
- The meeting included a detailed discussion on the feedback received from various stakeholders, including students, parents, teachers, alumni, and employers. Each group's concerns and suggestions were reviewed carefully. Key issues highlighted by stakeholders were thoroughly analysed, and appropriate decisions were made to address these concerns.

Decisions

- To support students in preparing for KMAT and LBS entrance examinations, it was
 decided to offer specialized coaching sessions. The Departments of Management
 Studies and Computer Applications were entrusted with coordinating and organizing
 these coaching programs to ensure students are well-prepared for these exams.
- Recognizing the growing importance of data analytics, a workshop for MBA students
 was proposed. The Department of Computer Applications will take charge of planning
 and organizing this workshop, aiming to equip students with essential data analytics
 skills.
- In alignment with the new NEP 2020 guidelines, a Faculty Development Programme
 (FDP) focusing on the proposed Four-Year Undergraduate Program (FYUGP) will be
 conducted. The IQAC was entrusted with coordinating this program to orient faculty
 members on the structure, objectives, and implementation of FYUGP.
